Our Trails

The initial trail was largely developed under the direction of a FCCA Director active in Parks Advocacy and volunteers over the years. SLRD funding allowed the following parks amenities to be added:

- Appropriate parks and trails signage
- A number of picnic tables
- Two memorial benches and several others at important park viewpoints
- A secondary trail (Twitcher) was constructed which provided a viewpoint (Tantalus Lookout) complete with an information board and custom bench
- Created a Spring Garden at Kingfisher Lookout with bulbs donated by community members and FCCA
- Installed Bio Sphere plaques at South Beach and Oliver's Landing Spit
- Installed an information photo on the trail to the beach to note the former logging heritage of Furry Creek



Advocacy and accomplishments

As part of the trails development, two UDT compost toilets were installed with support from the SLRD and Fine Peace giving residents and visitors access to facilities at the beach. Additionally:

Created Caretaker program for our trails and beaches with funding from the SLRD

Maintenance and repair of sidewalks, lighting and lampposts.

Liaise with the SLRD for Open Spaces maintenance and vendor RFQ input

Secure SLRD funding, purchase and maintenance as well as training on AED use.

Lobbying for and getting curbside waste pick up, glass recycling and seasonal green waste container.
