Near Term activities and focus areas of the board are:

- **FCCA Website** we are focused on finalizing and inviting our community to engage with FCCA via a website being built by a volunteer community member.
- *Open Spaces* Build a process with the SLRD and Tony Rainbow with a liaison

focused on monitoring and keeping scopes of work adhered to. Part of this is also

ensure areas like Stonegate gets included into roadside maintenance and areas

around Olivers Landing gets the correct treatment

- *Lamp post maintenance* - we will be mapping the state of each lamp post in Furry

Creek and any deficiencies so we are ensured uninterrupted light and a safe and

clean environment.

- *Miller Cap liaison* - this is to bring awareness to the debris and water which repeatedly

flows onto the main road from Logging road and discuss the process to get it remediated and repaired.

- **Sidewalks** In the new year we will begin a similar process to the lamp post project to ensure our sidewalks are safe and not an eyesore.
- We intend to build a budget process for both the lamp post and sidewalk maintenance,

and discuss the financial aspects with the SLRD and Tony Rainbow and subsequently update our members and community on next steps and process

- The Board will meet once informally in December before a Board meeting in January.
